#### 1. REPORT OF THE BOARD

### 1.1 FOUNDING AND GOALS

The foundation "Fundacion Salba Nos Burico" was founded in April 1997. The foundation is an independent non-profit organization, working with volunteers, whose goals are:

- a. Raising the consciousness of the Aruban people about their wild donkeys in general ('the Aruban donkeys");
- b. Preventing the disappearance of the Aruban donkeys and trying to create a habitat wherein the wild donkeys can lead a normal life; to preserve the donkeys as the cultural heritage of Aruba;
- c. Collecting and caring for those Aruban donkeys whose health/welfare has been impaired by injury/sickness/abandonment/mistreatment. We also wish to pick up all the donkeys currently on the street, to control the population and prevent them from being hit by cars.

#### 1.2 THE BOARD

In 2014 Desiree Jonkhoff and Anneke Korebrits-van den Hoogen stepped down, Anneke was replaced by Jaydee Perez and the position of Secretary was taken by Ilyana Maduro. We welcomed her as a new Board Member. We also welcomed Anton Isaak as advisor of the Board. At the end of 2014 the Board was made up of the following members:

The Foundation is made up exclusively of volunteers run by a managing director.

In 2014 there were about 40 active volunteers.

The Board is missing a Vice Chairman, 2nd Secretary and a 2nd Treasurer.

The Board actively seeks new members & volunteers.

#### 1.3 THE SANCTUARIES

The donkeys that the Foundation cares for are to be found at 3 locations:

Santa Lucia: 50 Bringamosa: 68 Seroe Alejandro: 13

There are 5 donkeys from the Sanctuaries currently on the street.

The donkeys being cared for at the end of 2014 numbered 136, including the ones on the street.

The Sanctuary at Santa Lucia's operating hours are: daily 9am to 4pm Monday through Friday and on the weekends from 10 am - 3 pm.

In September 2014 the first phase of the Stables was built with a donation of Afl 7500,- made by Aruba Way Foundation and a grant of Afl 16.000,-. By the Donkey Sanctuary of the UK. The second and third phase will be built after more fundraisers

We didn't reach the goal of moving all the donkeys to Bringamosa before the end of 2014. After 2 years the 5 year contract with the government for the Manager's wages were abruptly ended in July 2014, due to overall financial problems on the Island. We are still talking to the government about renewing the contract. As a solution we started to import hay ourselves instead of buying on the local market and paying a middle man. This is just one of the actions taken. In 2015 we will start a "support the Aruban Donkeys Program and we will also import the pellets through the same supplier. The Board is taking care of the Manager's wages for as long as possible

#### 1.4 INCOME

Fundraisers:

We made a reservation for building in Bringamosa.

We are actively fundraising for the new Sanctuary at the Service Clubs, Banks and Companies.

## 1.5 THE DONKEYS

In 2014 we had new rescues, arrivals and departures.

### **New Babies**

Diva, female was born October 4<sup>th</sup> and left behind by mama. She was bottle fed.

# Rescues (2)

Sir Wildwood a.k.a. Woody, male July 21 in front of Seroe Alejandro, a yearling Miracle, female from Seroe Colorado November 16, in labor for 48 hours. Survived!

## Passed away (6)

Sombrero, male Bringamosa found dead on February 9. Born in 2005 and bottle fed by us. Yearling, male Savaneta, attached by dogs, part of lungs eaten away, died during surgery May 3 Yearling female, Seroe Colorado. Found dead on July 16, unknown what happened. E.Z. Catch, male, August 7 hit by a car at Frenchman's Pass Baby for Miracle, male, died during labor. November 16 Female, hit by car Seroe Colorado November 16, euthanized November 17 due to internal bleeding.

Added to the group are 1 male and 2 females. The total group is 63% male and 37% female.

#### 1. General remarks

#### 1.1 Incorporation

The company was incorporated on April 14, 1997 and is statutory established in Aruba.

The company operates under the name Stichting Salba Nos Burico.

The address of the company is Noord Cura Cabai 80-A, Savaneta.

## 1.2 Goal

The main goal of the company is promoting awareness of the Aruban population in general regarding the wild donkeys on Aruba. The avoidance of enforcement of the Aruban donkeys and the pursuit of a habitat for the donkeys where they can live a full life.

## 1.3 Principles for the balance sheet valuation

Tangible fixed assets are valued at purchase price or production cost, minus cumulative depreciation and if applicable, special depreciation values. Depreciation is based on the estimated life cycle and are calculated based on a fixed percentage of the purchase price or manufacturing cost; taking into account any residual value. Depreciation occurs from the moment of usage. There is no depreciation for land.

## 1.4 Principles for profit determination

Costs are allocated to the reported year to which they relate.

Profits are recognized in the year in which the goods are delivered or the services are performed.

Losses are recognized in the year for which they relate to.

On mutual debt ratios an interest rate of 8% is charged per year.

In the case of private equity, no interest will be charged.
